- ❖ I will never ridicule or yell at my daughter or other participants for making a mistake.
- ❖ I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of all athletes, coaches and officials ahead of any personal desire I may have for my daughter to win.
- ❖ I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that could affect the safety of my daughter or others.
- ❖ I will respect all umpires and coaches and their authority during games, and I will never question, discuss or confront coaches or umpires at the game field. If I do have concerns with regards to any aspects of the club or its activities, I will arrange to speak privately with coaches or other club officials at a time and place agreed upon by all parties.
- ❖ I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team or the manager has requested my assistance.
